- A free and impartial education, training and careers website helping young people in our area plan their next steps after school
 - Learn about yourself and your strengths, skills, and aspirations
 - Research and apply for courses and apprenticeships
 - Complete the Skills Passport and use the CV builder tool
- You can access >log on | move on> at home, at school, or on mobile devices
- You do not need log in details to access the main information pages, you will only need to log in to access your account
- It's a quick and easy way to apply to more than one provider and track all applications in one place and you take your account with you when you move on to the next step in your training and education journey
